BIKE ROUTES

1 Cowichan Valley Wine Bike Route

The 12-km route is a great way to experience not only the different wines that Victoria has to offer but also local cuisine at the wineries who have bistros.

2 Shawnigan Lake

Shawnigan Lake is a 20 km paved road that circles the river.

3 Saanich Peninsula

The Saanich Peninsula is home to the routes: Strawberry Fields Forever, Lands End Loop, Best Beach Bike Route, Cole Bay Sun and Surf, and Flatlands Farm Route

4 Millstream Highlands

The Highlands contains an amazing maze of mountain biking trails which crisscrosses the hillsides of the Highlands for about 11 miles from downtown Victoria and contains some of the most intense downhill runs on the Vancouver Island.

5 Hartland Surplus/Mount Work

Hartland Surplus Lands takes place on Mount Work and it is the only designated mountain biking area on the Vancouver Island.

6 Cordova Bay Rd

Scenic road with spectacular water views.

7 Lochside Regional Trail

The Lochside Regional Trail is a 29 km/18 mi trail that winds through multiple sceneries of Victoria and connects to the Galloping Goose at the Switch Bridge.

8 Seaside Touring Route

The 11 km/7 mi is a designated bike trail specifically made for bikers wanting to see the scenery and landmarks along Victoria's coastline.
